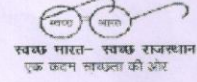

Dear Shri Jain,

The Central Monitoring Committee constituted under "Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act, 2013 (MS Act 2013)" in its fifth meeting held under the Chairmanship of Hon'ble Minister of Social Justice & Empowerment on 14.11.2017 to review the implementation of MS Act, 2013. A copy of the minutes of the above meeting is enclosed.

2. The Central Monitoring Committee has taken the following decisions:

- States to ensure mechanized cleaning of septic tanks and sewers by municipalities and contractors.
- To incorporate suitable clauses in the tender document of mandating issue and use of safety gear and equipment by the workmen engaged for cleaning of septic tanks.
- Also incorporate a condition in the tender document that contractor would be responsible to pay a compensation of Rs. 10 lakh in addition to the compensation paid by the State Government in the event of death workman in the septic tank while cleaning it without safety gear and devices.
- Payment of compensation of Rs.10 lakh by the State Government in all cases where part payment has been made, within next 15 days.
- All the States to identify the persons who were servicing the insanitary latrines which have been demolished and converted into sanitary latrines and include them in the list of identified manual scavengers.

**Subject:-Minutes of the fifth meeting of the Central Monitoring Committee held on 14<sup>th</sup> November, 2017 to review the implementation of the "Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Act, 2013".**

The meeting was chaired by **Shri Thaawarchand Gehlot, Minister of Social Justice & Empowerment.** List of participants is annexed.

**2 Secretary (SJ&E) welcomed the Members of the Committee and made the following observations:**

- From the data received in the Department of Social Justice & Empowerment and newspapers reports, it appears that the number of instances of manual scavenging and hazardous cleaning is increasing inspite of efforts made by the Government for identification of manual scavengers, their liberation and rehabilitation.
- In the last meeting held by the Hon'ble Minister on 30.08.2017, the State Commissions of Safai Karamcharis and the State Governments were advised to carry out field visits and ensure that the Municipalities/Contractors provide safety gear to the persons engaged for cleaning sewers and septic tanks. However, the instances of persons getting killed while cleaning septic tanks without any safety gear are still being reported. Effort should be made to prevent such deaths.
- The Committee would discuss the proposals for amendment of the existing provisions in the guidelines and Rules regarding hazardous cleaning and survey of manual scavengers so as to simplify the procedures and reduce the time taken for completing the survey and uploading the details of identified manual scavengers.
- The Committee would also discuss the initiatives undertaken by the National Safai Karamcharis Finance & Development Corporation (NSKFDC) in some States for rehabilitation of manual scavengers by providing alternative income generating activities.
- Only few States have taken up initiatives for the rehabilitation of adult family members and children of the manual scavengers. Other States should also initiate action in this regard.

- To deter engagement/employment of persons for hazardous cleaning of septic tanks without safety gear and devices it is proposed to add a condition in the tender document that the contractor would pay additional compensation of Rs. 10 lakh in the event of the workman's death while cleaning the septic tank without safety gear.
3. Thereafter Smt. Aindri Anurag, Member Secretary of the CMC and Joint Secretary, Department of Social Justice & Empowerment made a powerpoint presentation highlighting the following:
- Visuals of continued existence of dry-latrines and manual scavenging in some districts of Uttar Pradesh.
  - Initiatives taken by NSKFDC for the rehabilitation of manual scavengers.
  - Innovative projects undertaken in West Bengal and Andhra Pradesh for providing alternative income generating activities to the individual and Self Help Groups of manual scavengers.
  - Proposal for third party survey of manual scavengers in 15 major States to be completed in six months.
  - Proposal for amending the guidelines/Rules regarding survey of manual scavengers.
4. **Status reports presented by the Central Ministries and States**
- i. **Ministry of Drinking Water and Sanitation (Shri Samir Kumar, Economic Adviser)**
- Except three States viz. Arunachal Pradesh, Rajasthan and Jammu and Kashmir survey of insanitary latrines and their conversion into sanitary latrines has been completed.
- ii. **Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (Sh. V. K. Chaurasia, Adviser):**
- Informed that the focus of the Swachhh Bharat Abhiyan (Urban) being implemented by the Ministry is to make the entire country open defecation free by 2019. However, no data regarding conversion of insanitary latrines is being maintained under the mission.
- iii. **Ministry of Panchyati Raj (Sh. B. Das, Dy. Director):**

- Third party survey of manual scavengers has been awarded to Tata Institute of Social Services.

### **ix NCT Delhi (Smt. Renu Sharma, Principal Secretary, Urban Development),**

- NCT Delhi has issued directives regarding the safety measures to be followed by the Corporations as well as private contractors in engaging persons for cleaning sewers/septic tanks.
- Delhi Jal Board has organized training camps for 3000 persons to provide training in cleaning of sewers/septic tanks.
- Lt. Governor Delhi has constituted a three member committee to recommend action plan for total mechanization of septic tanks cleaning by 2018 and to suggest standard operating procedures.
- Secretary, SJE directed that present status on the following may be submitted within 10 days.
  - (i) FIRs filed against the contractors involved in the sewerage/septic tank related deaths cases.
  - (ii) Payment of compensation to the families of victims.
  - (iii) Incorporation of clause in the tender documents mandating issue/use of safety gear and devices to the workers engaged for hazardous cleaning of sewers/septic tanks.

### **x West Bengal (Shri Parthapratima Manna, Special Secretary and Managing Director, WB SCSTDW & Fin. Corporation, West Bengal)**

- Explained the Siliguri model of rehabilitation of manual scavengers under which the municipalities sign Memorandum of Understanding with self help groups of manual scavengers purchase ownership of equipment/vehicles for mechanised cleaning of the sewer lines and award of contracts to carrying out sanitation work and maintenance of sewer lines/septic tanks.

### **5 Observation/suggestions of other Members of the Committee**

A copy of the information received from the States and UTs of regarding the survey of insanitary latrines and manual scavengers in rural areas by Gram Panchayats was furnished.

**iv. Defence Estates (Sh. Rakesh Mittal, Additional Director General)**

- All the insanitary latrines in all the cantonments have been demolished and converted into sanitary latrines.
- Only mechanized cleaning is done for cleaning septic tanks.
- All the cantonments will be open defecation free by December, 2017.

**v. Ministry of Railways (Smt. Manju, Joint Director)**

- Submitted copies of the report regarding the action taken by Railways regarding construction of cemented aprons, providing safety gear to the workers engaged for cleaning of the toilets in passenger coaches and station areas.
- The Committee desired that the data needs to be got verified.

**vi. Department of Financial Services. of Financial Services (Smt. Vandita Kaul, Joint Secretary)**

- Public Sector Banks have reported that 9590 loan applications have been sanctioned. This information has to be cross-checked by NSKFDC with the banks.

**vii. Uttar Pradesh (Shri Vinod Kumar Tiwari, Dy. General Manager, (U.P. Scheduled Castes Finance Development Corporation)**

- Regarding the existence of insanitary latrines in Meerut and Jalaun districts of Uttar Pradesh, the photographs of which were shown in the powerpoint presentation, it was informed that instructions have been issued by the State Government for demolition of the insanitary latrines and their conversion into sanitary latrines in these districts.
- As regards the list of 31 manual scavengers in Servana Village and 98 manual scavengers in Jalaun district provided by the NSKFDC it has been informed that the details of self declared manual scavengers have been sent to local authorities for verification.

- A list of 119 persons who have died while cleaning septic tanks in different parts of the country during 2017 was provided by safai karamchari Andolan for verification and payment of compensation.
- A suggestion was made for associating social workers in the proposed third party survey of manual scavengers.
- Compensation in case of death in septic tanks may be increased.
- Waste pickers may also be included in the list of manual scavengers.
- Residential plots/houses may be provided to manual scavengers under Government schemes.

**xi Decisions taken by the Committee for implementation**

- To amend to the "Prohibition of Employment as Manual Scavengers and their Rehabilitation Rules, 2013" (MS Rules, 2013) for simplification of procedure for survey of manual scavengers and finalization of list of identified manual scavengers.
- To carry out third party survey of manual scavengers in 15 major States to be completed in six months in association with the State Governments and Social Workers.
- States to ensure mechanized cleaning of septic tanks and sewers by municipalities and contractors.
- To incorporate suitable clauses in the tender document of mandating issue and use of safety gear and equipment by the workmen engaged for cleaning of septic tanks.
- Also incorporate a condition in the tender document that contractor would be responsible to pay a compensation of Rs. 10 lakh in addition to the compensation paid by the State Government in the event of death workman in the septic tank while cleaning it without safety gear and devices.
- Payment of compensation of Rs.10 lakh by the State Government in all cases where part payment has been made, within next 15 days.

- State Safai Karamcharis Commissions and social workers to undertake field visits and follow up the cases of insanitary latrines, manual scavenging and hazardous cleaning with the concerned district authorities for taking appropriate action for conversion of insanitary latrines, identification of manual scavengers, filing of FIRs and payment of compensation in cases relating to hazardous cleaning.
  - Secretaries of the Central Government Departments and Chief Secretaries of the States to ensure that in future, Officers not below the rank of Joint Secretary to the Government of India/Principal Secretary only are nominated for attending the meetings of the CMC.
  - Ministry of Railways to carry out inspection of Zonal Railways and verify whether the workers engaged for cleaning toilets in passenger coaches and station areas are provided with safety gear and devices and submit a report .
  - Chairman, Railway Board or a senior officer not below the rank of Joint Secretary to Government of India to attend the CMC meeting in future.
  - Department of Financial Services in consultation with NSKFDC to verify the report of the Public Sector Banks regarding pending loan applications and issue instructions to the banks for clearance of pending applications on a time bound basis.
  - State Government of Uttar Pradesh to submit a report regarding the present status of demolition insanitary latrines identified by NSKFDC in two districts viz. Meerut and Jalaun and also complete the verification of lists of self declared manual scavengers submitted by individuals, NGOs and NSKFDC.
  - All the States to identify the persons who were servicing the insanitary latrines which have been demolished and converted into sanitary latrines and include them in the list of identified manual scavengers.
- xii Concluding remarks of Hon'ble Minister of Social Justice & Empowerment:**

Hon'ble Minister appreciated the work done by Central Ministries and State Governments. He desired that there should be more commitment by all the Members to ensure implementation of various provisions of the Act to achieve the objectives of complete eradication of manual scavenging and rehabilitation of all the manual scavengers. Social Workers and State Commissions of Safai Karamcharis were requested to undertake field visits and interact with the local authorities regularly to monitor identification and rehabilitation manual scavengers, filing of FIRs in cases relating to hazardous cleaning and payment of compensation to the families of victims of sewerage/septic tank related deaths. He suggested that there should be more emphasis on skill development to equip the beneficiaries for undertaking employment on sustainable basis. He suggested that NSKFDC and State Channelizing Agencies should provide assistance for completing documentation required to avail bank loans. He appreciated the proposals for the amendment of MS Rules,2013 to simplify the procedures for survey of manuals scavengers and directed that necessary action may be initiated for carrying out third party survey in consultation with the States and UTs.
